It is famous for its, tea gardens, natural beauty, wild life reserves (specially one horned Asiatic Rhino), temples (Kamakya), monuments and mighty Brahmaputra River. Assam is a land of natural beauty, cultural richness. It offers a peculiar composite culture, of myriad hues. Dispur is the state capital and Guwahati is the largest city in the state. Bihu is Assam's one of the most important festivals. The population of Assam represents a unique combination of various ethnic sects that inhabit the rich land from a very long time.

Travelling to Dakshin Kamrup Girls' College

The easiest and fastest way to go Dakshin Kamrup Girls' College, Mirza is LGB International Airport, Borjhar, Guwahati which is 8 km away from the college. Besides air link, the college is 29 km away from Guwahati Railway Station. A direct flight or train from any city of India to Guwahati (Assam) is available on daily on advance booking system. From Guwahati the delegates may avail bus, tourist taxi (Uber, Ola etc.) services from Guwahati to Mirza, (N.H. 37 Jalukbari to Goalpara Road just 18 km away) Near Palasbari police Station.

Accommodation

Outstation members of the Association will be accommodated in the Dakshin Kamrup Girls' College, hostel, D.K. College, hostel and NITS hostel, Office's Quarter of the Kochpara Veterinary in Mirza. Members are requested not to bring their families as we are not in a position to accommodate them. Accommodation will only be arranged for those members who inform the undersigned by 25th September, 2017. Members who confirm their participation in the conference will be informed of their accommodation by 29th September 2017.

Reception and Registration
